Scholarship Application Packet and Instructions

Deadline: Last Friday in May

The Central Washington Home Builders Association has established a scholarship program. Each year, two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to students pursuing post high school education. CWHBA welcomes any member, family member or an employee of a CWHBA member company to apply for a CWHBA Scholarship. The scholarship may be used to fund almost any post-secondary education, i.e., college or vocational, public or private. Post-secondary education has to be in the construction field to receive the scholarship. Monies will be paid directly to the school of choice of the winners to help defray the cost of tuition and/or fees.

The Remodelers Council of Central Washington has established the Cliff Tanasse Scholarship in memoriam of former member Cliff Tanasse. The scholarship amount is based on the financial performance of the Cliff Tanasse Scholarship fund. The scholarship may be used to fund almost any post-secondary education, i.e., college or vocational, public or private. Monies will be paid directly to the school of choice of the winners to help defray the cost of tuition and/or fees.

Application Packet

You must submit the following four items to complete your application packet:

1. The CWHBA Scholarship Application Form. Please fill in all blanks completely, or mark with 'N/A' if not applicable. Information is strictly confidential. Please note which Scholarship you are applying for, The CWHBA Scholarship or the Cliff Tanasse Scholarship or both.
2. Three letters of recommendation from persons who will describe qualifications that make you a logical choice for one of CWHBA's scholarships. At least two letters should be from people who interact with you in your professional life: supervisors, co-workers, teachers, etc.
3. An unofficial copy of your academic transcripts from the last two semesters, three quarters, or include a copy of your most recent transcript.
4. An essay on your career goals.

All applicants and supporting materials must be postmarked by Last Friday in May. All applicants will be mailed notice of their final status.

Evaluation Criteria

Applications will be judged according to the following criteria:

- 20% Academic Record
- 20% Work Experience
- 15% Community Service/School Activities
- 15% Recommendations
- 15% Financial Need
- 20% Essay

Distribution of Funds

Checks will be issued to the school of record.

Subsequent Scholarships

Scholarship awards are made for one academic year only. You are welcome to reapply for aid in subsequent years.
